



## Activity Worksheet

# Anchoring our hearts on God's desires for human relationships

This activity invites group members to reflect on and share God's heart for relationships.

### Preparation

1. You will need a flip-chart or dry erase board and markers.
2. Print and cut the enough worksheets so that each member of your group and can have one. (See page 2)

### Engagement

1. As your members gather, give each person one of the three instructions listed below. (See page 2)
2. Ask your members to write down their words and hold onto their pages until everyone arrives.
3. When everyone arrives, invite your group to share their words for each topic. Write the words down on the flip-chart or dry board.
  - a. Instruction 1: Choose three words that characterize the relationships God desires for people who interact with one another in public spaces to have.
  - b. Instruction 2: Choose three words that characterize the relationships God desires for spouses to have with each other.
  - c. Instruction 3: Choose three words that characterize the relationships God desires for friends to have with each other.
4. Take your time, making sure to really treasure the words that are shared.
5. Use the words you've collected as you pray for your gathering,

### Group Reflection

1. Invite 2 or 3 participants to talk briefly about their experience of sharing the sharing the words the member's chose.

Instruction 1: Choose three words that characterize the relationships God desires for people who interact with one another in public spaces to have.

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Instruction 2: Choose three words that characterize the relationships God desires for spouses to have with each other.

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Instruction 3: Choose three words that characterize the relationships God desires for friends to have with each other.

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
